## **TIPS**

- Look through a picture book together. Tell stories about what you see.

- Singing songs also teaches your child a lot.

## **LEARN DUTCH**

  The Dutch text is read aloud. So you can hear the right pronunciation right away.
- Watch DVDs of books together. The Dutch text is also read aloud here.
